

An Accessible City – transport projects: proposed changes



This St Asaph Street transport project is needed to support the recovery of the Central City including improved traffic flow and better cycling facilities.

Key features of the proposal include:

- an enhanced cycle network connecting with other cycle routes including the Major Cycle Routes
- an enhanced one-way street network St Asaph Street continues as a key east-to-west one-way corridor
- an enhanced environment including new islands, more trees and improved lighting.
