ALCOHOL RESTRICTIONS IN PUBLIC PLACES AMENDMENT BYLAW 2012

PERMANENT ALCOHOL BAN AREAS FOR MERIVALE AND PAPANUI

The Christchurch City Council has approved an amendment to the Council's Alcohol Restrictions in Public Places Bylaw 2009 to include Merivale and Papanui in the schedule of permanent alcohol ban areas.

Permanent alcohol bans for Merivale and Papanui will apply on seven nights a week from 6pm to 6am, from 9 September 2012.

Until 9 September 2012, temporary alcohol bans for Merivale and Papanui apply on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday nights from 6pm to 6am.

People are not permitted to consume alcohol or to have open containers of alcohol – including within vehicles - in the public places of an alcohol ban area. Under the 2009 Bylaw and the Local Government Act 2002, the Police have a range of enforcement powers. They are able to search people's bags and vehicles (in certain situations) and to arrest people found to be breaching the 2009 Bylaw.

AMENDMENT TO THE CHRISTCHURCH CITY DISTRICT PLAN TO IMPLEMENT CHRISTCHURCH CENTRAL RECOVERY PLAN

The Christchurch City District Plan has been amended from the date of this Notice pursuant to statutory direction 1 and Appendix 1 of the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan in accordance with a direction given by the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery pursuant to section 24 of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011.

Section 24(5) of the Canterbury Earthquake Recovery Act 2011 provides that only the Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery can request a change or variation to such provisions introduced through the Recovery Plan.
