

SUMMIT ROAD PROTECTION AUTHORITY VACANCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE

The Summit Road Protection Authority has responsibilities for the preservation and protection of the scenic amenities associated with the Summit Road. The Authority is a joint Committee of the Christchurch City Council and the Selwyn District Council and is advised by an Advisory Committee. A vacancy has arisen on this Committee for one of the two representatives of the land owners. Enquiries are welcomed from land owners within the protected area. This area runs from Gebbes Pass to Evans Pass and between the Summit of the Port Hills and a line generally 30 metres below the Summit Road.
