CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL DRAFT WASTE MANAGEMENT AND MINIMISATION PLAN 2013

The Christchurch City Council is proposing to put in place a Waste Management Plan under the requirements of the Waste Minimisation Act 2008.

The Waste Minimisation Act requires all territorial authorities review their waste management policies. The Waste Management Plan will be a statutory plan that will sit in a wider national, regional and local policy and planning context.

The proposed new Waste Management and Minimisation Plan 2013 therefore proposes actions to build on successes already achieved and actively works toward zero waste to landfill.

The following targets for 2020 are proposed:

- Reduce annual residual waste sent to landfill to 320 kilograms per person (currently 524 kilograms per person).
- Reduce annual green and kitchen waste sent to the organics processing plant to 30 kilograms per person (currently 87 kilograms per person).
- Reduce annual recoverable paper and cardboard sent to the materials recovery facility to 30 kilograms per person of (currently 38 kilograms per person).

The draft Plan will be publicly consulted on from 4 May to 7 June 2013.

Your feedback is important to help guide the Council's decision-making.
