

## NOTIFICATION OF COUNCILS INTENTION TO CONSIDER THE GRANTING OF A NEW LICENCE AGREEMENT FOR A COMMERCIAL ROPES BASED COURSE AT SEAFIELD PARK SPENCERVILLE - ADRENALIN FOREST LIMITED

Since 1 October 2006 Adrenalin Forest Limited have occupied approximately 5 hectares of Allotment RS 40231, a Recreational Reserve as notified in the New Zealand Gazette 1973/742, to operate a commercial rope based adventure course.
