NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DECLARE LAND AS RESERVE

The Christchurch City Council has acquired 201 Annex Road with a total area of 10.1694 hectares more or less of land for stormwater retention purposes. This large parcel of land was identified as being suitably sized and positioned in the Upper Heathcote sub catchment, known as Curletts Drain, to site a major water quality mitigation facility.

In order to better protect and manage this property in accordance with the purpose it is being held for, the Council proposes to reserve the land as Local Purpose (Stormwater Retention) Reserve within the meaning of Section 23 of the Reserves Act 1977.

Pursuant to Section 14 of the Reserves Act 1977, this is a notice that the Council intends to pass a resolution to declare the land as a Local Purpose (Stormwater Retention) Reserve, being legally described as:

0.5629 hectares more or less being Section 1 SO Plan 461179
7.9007 hectares more or less being Section 2 SO Plan 461179
1.7058 hectares more or less being Section 3 SO Plan 461179
