Please note that should Main Road Sumner be compromised Summit Road will be opened immediately to provide a route to Sumner.

These closures are proposed to be made under paragraph 11(e) of the Tenth Schedule of the Local Government Act 1974. The proposed closures will apply to all vehicular traffic with the exception of emergency service vehicles and vehicles directly engaged in the event.
