

## CHANGING ROOM FACILITY AT SOUTH HAGLEY PARK CANTERBURY RUGBY FOOTBALL UNION NEW I FASE TERM

The Canterbury Rugby Football Union has made an application for a new lease over the changing room area of approximately 72 square metres the Club occupies at South Hagley Park, in a joint venture with the Christchurch City Council. The Council maintains the toilet facility in the structure, the overall building area encompassing the changing room and toilets being approximately 152 square metres. South Hagley Park is administered by the Christchurch City Council as a reserve for recreation purposes.

This is notice that the Council is to consider the granting of a new lease to the Canterbury Rugby Football Union for a period of up to 33 years, broken into 3 terms of 11 years each. Any granting of a new lease will be pursuant to Section 54 (1) (b) (c) of the Reserves Act 1977, over approximately 72 square meters of Rural Section 41182 held for Recreation purposes as detailed on page 2706 of New Zealand Gazette Notice of 25 November 2000.
