



CHRISTCHURCH CITY COUNCIL REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR A LICENCE TO GRAZE SHEEP AT 3370 CHRISTCHURCH/AKAROA ROAD

The Christchurch City Council invites proposals for a grazing licence to graze sheep at the above address. The purpose of the grazing licence is to achieve grazing of the land at a level that will enhance native plant species and habitat for native fauna, and also ensure that exotic grass growth is maintained to an acceptable level so that no fire hazard arises. The licence is intended to be granted under Section 74(2) (a) of the Reserves Act 1977 for a period of five years commencing five days after it is approved by the Akaroa/Wairewa Community Board.

Schedule

The proposal relates to land titles held for Recreation and Conservation Purposes under page 1804 of the New Zealand Gazette 2005, Part Reserve 3185(SO4752)DCDB Document ID CT 8K/912, Rural Section 41246(SO15288) Local Purpose Reserve (Gravel Pit and Refuse Disposal) New Zealand Gazette 1981 Page 502, being approximately 109.41 hectares in total.

Proposals are to be in accordance with the document titled “Request for Proposals for Grazing Licence – 3370 Christchurch/Akaroa Road”, dated August 2014 (RFP No 14/15-68), and must be deposited in the Tender Box at the Civic Offices, 53 Hereford Street, Christchurch, by Noon on Wednesday 29 October 2014.
