PROPOSAL TO ADOPT ANNUAL PLAN FOR 2014/15 AND TO MAKE AMENDMENTS TO THE THREE YEAR PLAN

Notice is given, pursuant to the Local Government Act 2002, of a proposal by the Christchurch City Council to adopt an Annual Plan for 2014/15 and to make amendments to the Three Year Plan.

At its meeting on 25 February 2014, the Council resolved that the Draft Annual Plan for 2014/15, and amendments to the Three Year Plan, updating the fees and charges schedule, the rates remissions and rates postponement policies, and amending the development contributions policy, be distributed for public consultation. Submissions may be made between 17 March 2014 and 5pm on 22 April 2014.

The Statement of Proposal for the Draft Annual Plan and amendments to the Three Year Plan will be available for inspection from Monday 17 March 2014 during ordinary office hours at the following places:

1. Civic Offices, 53 Hereford St, Christchurch (reception, ground floor)
2. All Christchurch City Council libraries
3. All Christchurch City Council service centres.

A copy of the summary document will be distributed to all households in the Council's district from 15 March 2014. A copy may be requested by phoning (03) 941-8999 or 0800 800 169 (freephone for Banks Peninsula residents only).

Submissions on the proposal may be made in writing to the Council between Monday 17 March and 5pm Tuesday 22 April 2014. These may be made:

2. By using the submission form contained in the document; or
3. In any other written form.

Any person who makes a submission will have the opportunity to be heard by the Council, but must make that request. The submitter's name, address and contact telephone number must be included on the first page. No anonymous submissions will be accepted. Hearings will be held from 14 to 19 May 2014. We are legally required to make all written or electronic submissions available to the public and to Councillors, including the name and address of the submitter. The submissions, including all contact details provided, will be available to the public subject to the provisions of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987. If you consider there to be compelling reasons why your contact details and/or submission should be kept confidential, you should first discuss this with the Council, telephone 941-8999.
