1. On 28 November 2014 the Christchurch City Council publicly notified a plan change request by Memorial Avenue Investments Limited that seeks to rezone approximately 24.55 hectares of land bounded by Memorial Avenue, Russley Road and Avonhead Road to Industrial Park Zone (Memorial Avenue).

6. Further submissions must be served on the Christchurch City Council. A copy must also be served by the further submitter on Barrie Symon, Jeff and Sandra Walker, or Tim Hunter within five working days after the further submission is served on the Christchurch City Council.
