PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF SUBMISSIONS AND RIGHT TO MAKE FURTHER SUBMISSIONS

1. On 9 February 2016 the Christchurch City Council publicly notified proposals for:
 - Residential Medium Density zoning at Hornby, Linwood and Papanui
 - Corridor Protection Setback rules for an electricity distribution line between Heathcote and Lyttelton
 - A 500m² GLFA maximum tenancy for offices in some Commercial and Industrial zones
2. The period for making submissions on the proposal closed on 22 March 2016.
3. The submissions received are now available for public inspection and may be inspected during normal office hours at any of the Council's service centre and libraries. For details of your nearest service centre or library please telephone 941 8999. The submissions may also be viewed online at www.proposeddistrictplan.ccc.govt.nz.
4. The following persons may make a further submission **by no later than Friday 15 April 2016**:
 - The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery and the Minister for the Environment.
 - Any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest.
 - Any person that has an interest in the proposal greater than the interest that the general public has.
 - Christchurch City Council.
5. Any further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or in opposition to, any relevant submission made on the proposal and must state whether or not you wish to be heard.
6. Further submissions must be served on the Christchurch City Council. A copy must also be served by the further submitter on the original submitter within five working days after the further submission is served on the Christchurch City Council.
