## **PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF LATE SUBMISSIONS ON PROPOSED CHRISTCHURCH REPLACEMENT PLAN AND RIGHT TO MAKE FURTHER SUBMISSION**

- Under the provisions of Clause 5(1)(b) of Schedule 3 Canterbury Earthquake (Christchurch Replacement District Plan) Order 2014, the Chair of the Independent Hearings Panel has accepted a late submission from:
    - James and Mary Koh who seek to amend the reference to rule 5.8.7 in their submission #3990 to refer to rule 5.8.7 P10 and 5.8.8.
    - Paul Francis who seeks relief relating to the relocation of the Carrs Road Kart Club.
    - Lewelyn Davis who seeks to remove an Outstanding Natural Landscape notation from the property at 71 Hawkhurst Road Lyttelton.
    - Christ's College Canterbury and G and J McVicar who seek relief in relation to Chapter 5 Natural Hazards in addition to relief already sought in submission #3677.

    - The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery and the Minister for the Environment.
    - Any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest.
    - Any person that has an interest in the proposal greater than the interest that the general public has.
    - Christchurch City Council.
  - Any further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or in opposition to the submissions made by James and Mary Koh (submission points 3 and 4 only), Paul Francis, Lewelyn Davis, or Christ's College Canterbury and G and J McVicar (submission points 15 to 25 inclusive only) and must state whether or not you wish to be heard.
  - The further submission must be served on the Christchurch City Council. A copy must also be served by the further submitter on relevant submitter within five working days after the further submission is served on the Christchurch City Council.
