



DECISIONS OF THE INDEPENDENT HEARINGS PANEL ON THE CHRISTCHURCH REPLACEMENT DISTRICT PLAN TO BE MADE OPERATIVE

In accordance with Clause 15(2)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake (Replacement District Plan) Order 2014 (the Order), the following proposals were deemed to have been approved by Christchurch City Council under clause 17(1) of Schedule 1 Resource Management Act 1991 on and from the dates on which the appeal period against the decisions of the Independent Hearings Panel expired.

- Decision 5: Designation D1 (Part) Christchurch International Airport Limited
- Decision 5: Designations and Heritage Order excluding Christchurch International Airport Limited
- Decision 7: Transport (Stage 1) and 2 decisions making minor corrections to Decision 7
- Decision 9: Temporary Activities 6A, 6B and 6C

In accordance with Clause 16(1) of the Order, the provisions subject to the proposals described above will become operative on 18 December 2015.
