PUBLIC NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF SUBMISSIONS AND RIGHT TO MAKE FURTHER SUBMISSIONS

1. On 25 July 2015 the Christchurch City Council publicly notified a number of proposals and associated planning maps to replace some of the provisions of the operative Christchurch City Plan and the Banks Peninsula District Plan. The period for making submissions on those proposals closed on 4 September 2015.
2. On 4 September 2015 the Council gave notice that the Chair of the Independent Hearings Panel had extended the period for making submissions on the Coastal Environment Proposal (Chapter 19) and associated planning maps under clause 5 of Schedule 3 of the Christchurch Earthquake (Christchurch Replacement District Plan) Order 2014. The period for making submissions on that proposal closed on 16 October 2015.
3. The submissions received on the Coastal Environment Proposal and associated planning maps are now available for public inspection. The submissions may be inspected during normal office hours at any of the Council's Service Centre offices, Council Libraries and on-line at www.proposeddistrictplan.ccc.govt.nz. For details of your nearest Service Centre or Library please telephone 941 8999.
4. The following persons may make a further submission:
 - The Minister for Canterbury Earthquake Recovery and the Minister for the Environment.
 - Any person representing a relevant aspect of the public interest.
 - Any person that has an interest in the proposal greater than the interest that the general public has.
 - Christchurch City Council.
5. Any further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or in opposition to, any relevant submission made on the proposal and must state whether or not you wish to be heard.
6. Further submissions must be served on the Christchurch City Council by no later than Monday 16 November 2015. A copy must also be served by the further submitter on the original submitter within five working days after the further submission is served on the Christchurch City Council.
