5. Any further submission must be limited to a matter in support of, or in opposition to, any relevant submission made on the proposal and must state whether or not you wish to be heard.
6. Further submissions must be served on the Christchurch City Council by no later than Friday 2 October 2015. A copy must also be served by the further submitter on the original submitter within five working days after the further submission is served on the Christchurch City Council.
