# **Chapter 13 Central City**

# 13.13.1.2 Temporary lifting or moving earthquake damaged buildings within the Central City

#### 13.13.1.2.1 How to use these rules

13.13.1.2.1.1 These rules apply only to the Temporary Earthquake Recovery Areas identified in Appendix 6.1 within the Central City.

Note: The rules relating to the temporary lifting or moving of earthquake damaged buildings in Temporary Earthquake Recovery Areas outside of the Central City, identified in Appendix 6.1, are in Chapter 6, under Clause 6.4.4. The rules relating to the temporary lifting or moving of earthquake damaged buildings in Residential Suburban, Residential Suburban Density Transition, Residential Medium Density, or Residential Banks Peninsula Zones are included in Chapter 14 under Clauses 14.2..2, 14.3.2, 14.4.2 and 14.5.2.

Words underlined are defined terms in Chapter 2 Definitions of the Replacement District Plan.

## 13.13.1.2.2 Activity status tables

#### 13.13.1.2.2.1 Permitted Activities

The activities listed below are permitted activities in any Area identified in Appendix 6.1 within the Central City, if they comply with the Activity Specific Standards set out in this table.

The activities listed below are restricted discretionary activities.

Discretion to grant or decline consent and impose conditions is restricted to the matters of discretion set out in the following table.
