## Akaroa Temporary Visitor centre for cruise season 2012/13

Due to the closure of the Lyttelton Port to the cruise ships after the February earthquake the cruises were rerouted through Akaroa. A temporary visitor centre in a small 3 x 2 m cabin was located at the road end of the main wharf and operated by the Akaroa visitor centre staff/Akaroa District Promotions (ADP) and ADP members.

### <u> Plan</u>


The plan for the upcoming cruise season is to operate a temporary visitor centre from October 2012 to May 2013 to welcome cruise ship passengers for the 12/13 season. For the forthcoming season a larger visitors centre 6 x 2.9 m cabin is requested to better accommodate the estimated 200,000 passengers. This cabin would ideally have 2 doors or a larger ranch slider entrance, and ideally be connect to mains power. The visitor centre is marked out on the draft concept plan for this area and a hard copy of an aerial view of the site is available. The Akaroa Visitor centre has also applied for a permit for "Temporary Use of a legal road"









Appical pile detail.
