The Maadi Cup is the name given to the New Zealand Secondary Schools Rowing Regatta. The regatta is the largest school sports event in the Southern Hemisphere and is held alternatively at Lake Karapiro in the Waikato region and Lake Ruataniwha, near Twizel. An expected 1,900 rowers from 120 schools will take part in the event. The Avonside Girls School Rowing Team struggled last year going from an 18 member squad down to seven due to the earthquakes. Last year the team travelled to Auckland and Ashburton to train. The team is now up to 9 members and is in a rebuilding phase. Being able to compete will assist in that rebuilding and bring some positive outcomes for the community.
