

## DECISIONS OF THE INDEPENDENT HEARINGS PANEL ON THE CHRISTCHURCH REPLACEMENT DISTRICT PLAN TO BE MADE OPERATIVE

In accordance with Clause 15(2)(a) of the Canterbury Earthquake (Replacement District Plan) Order 2014, (the Order) the following proposals were deemed to have been approved by the Christchurch City Council under clause 17(1) of Schedule 1 of the Resource Management Act 1991, on and from the dates on which the appeal period against the decisions of the Independent Hearings Panel expired.

- Decision 8: Natural Hazard (Part) Planning Maps (appeal period expired 30 September 2015)
- Decision 12:Transport (part) (and relevant definitions) (appeal period expired 15 February 2016)
   Decision 14: Specific Purpose (Burwood Landfill and
- Resource Recovery Park) (appeal period expired 18 March 2016)
- Decision to make minor corrections to Decision 14 (appeal period expired 31 March 2016)

In accordance with clause 16(1) of the Order, the provisions subject to the proposals described above will become operative on 14 April 2016.
